Eucharistic Procession

Fr. Nathan's Eucharistic Article 37 of 40

"You nourished your people with food of angels and furnished them Bread from heaven, ready to hand, untoiled-for, endowed with all delights and conforming to every taste" (Wis 16:20)

After Communion, the priest returns to the altar and collects any remaining particles. He purifies the paten or ciborium over the chalices, and then the chalice. In silence he prays:

Lord, may I receive these gifts in purity of heart. May they bring me healing and strength, now and forever.

You will notice that the priest and/or deacon takes careful time purifying each of the vessels and folding the corporeal (i.e. the upper cloth). While this may seem like a waste of time, it is meant to show reverence for the Eucharist since even under the tiniest particle of host or drop of Precious Blood, our Lord is still fully present. From my perspective at the altar, there are always leftover fragments (e.g. broken pieces, small specs of the hosts, etc.). To not address this would be tantamount to leaving a consecrated host unguarded on the altar. Not only is that disrespectful, it opens the door to sacrilege. One of the worst things a parish can ever do is to become careless with the Blessed Sacrament, because that would soon lead to indifference, which in turn will lead to faithlessness.

During this period of time, silence or a song may be played. The ultimate point of this time is to foster a space for reflection, so that the faithful are able to process what has taken place and how best they can react to the graces received. There is no one set of prescribed prayers to be said. Some days, our post Communion prayers will be filled with thanksgiving, as we are most mindful of our Lord's blessings in our life. Other days we may be more aware of our unworthiness and sinfulness, and so we use this time to repent and consider adjustments. Perhaps we may find ourselves still in awe of the mystery of that day's readings and/or the sacrament, and find ourselves in blissful contemplation. The point is that the Holy Spirit will always pull at our heart differently so that we are in the best position going forward ... this post Communion period is best suited for following the Spirit's lead.

After this time of reflection, the priest will stand and say, "Let us Pray." The final collect is read (cf. art. 22). You will often notice in this final prayer an emphasis on allowing the Eucharist to take effect in our lives: graces for the soul; increase in the theological virtues and gifts of the Holy Spirit; remedy for the body; unity of the Mystical Body of Christ (i.e. the Church); and eternal life. For example, consider our simple closing collect for this weekend's Mass:

May your healing work, O Lord, free us, we pray, from doing evil and lead us to what is right. Through Christ our Lord. Amen. Fr. Nathan

After my 2013 trip to Tanzania with Fr. Mark and fellow parishioners, we answered the call to fund a roof for a rural church that had been waiting eleven years without. With your help, over the next ten years, five more churches have been built in that region, along with two rectories, two wells dug, many generators and solar panels installed, and a minibus purchased for emergency transportation. At present, three more churches are almost completed, one holding more than 1000! This 2024 trip marks over a ton of tiny sacramentals, that you provided, placed in the hands of thousands of impoverished. The conversation to Catholicism in the Mbulu region has been exponential!

I rest now under the Tanzanian sunset thanking God for your faithful generosity and prayers over the years. All your gifts for our Tanzanian mission, regardless of size, have brought such hope and joy to so many people in with Ellen Millott so little.
